



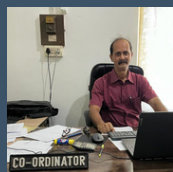

- National Science Day 2022: A Quiz Competition was organized by Duliajan College Science Council on 28th February 2022 on the occasion of National Science Day.

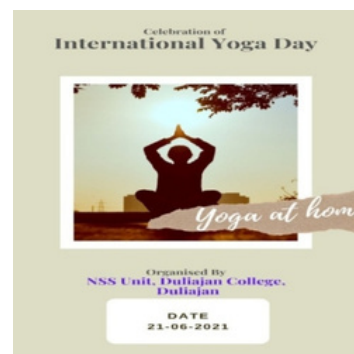


ARTS FORUM

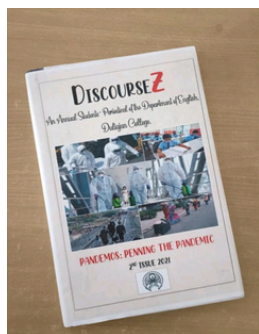
DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

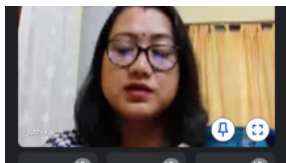

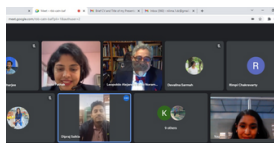

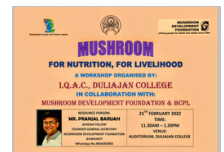
