- Protection and Preservation of Indian Traditional Knowledge
- * Assessing the value of Indian Traditional Knowledge in the global market

Format of the Paper/ Article:

- Maximum word limit: For Research paper/ Review Article- 3000
 - For Short Communications- 1000
- ➢ Font style of the text: Times New Roman
- \succ Font size: 12
- ▶ Line spacing: 1.15
- Structure of the Paper/Article:
 - Title- Should be informative and precise and typed in Bold, Font size 14, Uppercase and Centered
 - Author's name and affiliation- Should be in Bold, Font size 12 and Centered. Corresponding Author should be highlighted using asterisk (*). Author Names should be followed by the Author's/ Authors' affiliation typed in Font size 10, Line spacing 1.15 and Centered. In case of Authors with different affiliation, Superscripted 'a', 'b' (in Italics) etc. can be used.

- Abstract- An abstract maximum of 250 words should be given at the beginning of the paper. Font size of text here should be 10.
- Keywords- The abstract of the paper should be followed by five Keywords typed in Italics and Font size 10.
- Header format- Heading should be written in Uppercase Bold, while the Sub-Headings can be in Low case Bold and Next Heading (if there) will be in Lowercase Italics
- > Citation- In-text citation should be used.
 - *For papers in Science domain*, the source should be numbered in square brackets which refer to the full citation listed in the reference list at the end of the paper.

e.g. "This theory was first put forward in 1987 [1]."

- For papers in Humanities or Commerce domain, MLA citation style should be followed which includes the author's surname and page number/s in parenthesis, e.g. "This claimed that....(Smith 173)"
- Reference- The Reference List should appear at the end of the paper and provide the full citations for all the references that have been used throughout the paper. Font size: 10.
 - *For manuscripts in Science domain*, RSC style of referencing should be adopted-

e.g. T. J. Hebden, R. R. Schrock, M. K. Takase and P. Müller, *Chem. Commun.*, 2012, **48**, 1851–1853.

Books should be cited in the form: A. Name, B. Name and C. Name, Book Title, Publisher, Publisher Location, year.

e.g. S. T. Beckett, Science of Chocolate, Royal Society of Chemistry, Cambridge, 2000.

• *For manuscripts in Humanities or Commerce domain*, MLA 8th Edition referencing style should be adopted for citing papers.

For books: Author's Last Name, First Name. Title of Book (Italicized). Publisher, Year of Publication.

e.g. Smith, John. The Art of Writing. Penguin Books, 2020.

For citing papers in Conference Proceedings:

e.g. D. Hirahara and S. Borah, "Experimental study of external interference for LEO-based sensing (AIS)," in Advances in Communications Satellite Systems. Proc. of the 37th Int. Communications Satellite Systems Conf. (ICSSC-2019), 2019, pp. 1-10.

- Language: Apart from English, Authors can send their Papers in Assamese and Bengali language.
 - Manuscripts written in Assamese should be typed in *Geetanjali* font in *Ramdhenu* software.
 - Manuscripts written in Bengali should be typed in Kalpurush font in Abhro software.

 Submission of manuscripts: Manuscripts of Paper/Article/Short Communication in given template (attached below) can be sent to the Editor @ Email id: krchem3@gmail.com. *The word file of the Template can be availed in Duliajan College website.*

The submitted manuscripts will be first assessed by the Editor and then sent for **doubleblind peer review** (where neither authors nor reviewers know each other's name or affiliations). The Editors will have the right to revert or reject a paper, if not found in prescribed format or do not align with the given theme, before processing for review. After recommendation from Reviewers for acceptance of a paper, members of Editorial Board will contact the Author for the Printing and Publication charge. The decision of the Board will be FINAL.

- Self-Declaration: Authors must submit a Self-declaration in the given format to ensure that the Research paper/ Article submitted to this journal is his/ her/their original work and not published elsewhere. In addition to that, Authors are encouraged to submit plagiarism report along with their article; though NOT mandatory.
- **Publication Charge** Authors need to pay Rupees **1500**/- as Printing and Publication Charge which needs to be paid after acceptance of the paper.
