

Analysis Report of The Feedback on Syllabus and its transaction 2024-2025






1. Streams available in Duliajan College


2. Your course of study at Duliajan College


3. The curriculum and syllabus are need-based






5. The sequence of the units provided in the course is appropriate




6. The syllabus is useful in terms of knowledge, concepts, analytical abilities and broadening perspectives


7. Adequate textbooks, reference books or digital resources are available related to the syllabus


8. The course outcomes are well-defined and clear






10. The courses enhanced your critical thinking and problem-solving skills




11. The syllabus fulfills the competencies expected by the present global scenario


12. The syllabus offers the flexibility in choosing electives

13. For better academic performance, do you think you need-




14. Has the project work (if any) boost your technical skills
