

About Duliajan College:

Duliajan College is located at a beautiful site with its glory and radiance in the heart of the oil township of Duliajan amidst oil and gas fields, sprawling greenery of the surrounding tea gardens and cultivation lands. This premier institution of higher education was started on the 1st August 1969 to cater the needs of quality education in the locality. Since its inception, the college has been blossoming to be the foremost institution of higher education in the easternmost region of the country.

The College is permanently affiliated to Dibrugarh University and approved under sections 2 (f) and 12 (B) of the UGC Act, 1956, in the years 1986. The college boasts of a vibrant environment through participative and decentralized involvement of students, teachers, alumni, guardians, retired teachers and local community in various perspectives and activities. It has already been assessed and accredited by NAAC thrice during 2005, 2010 and 2023 obtaining scores of 76, 2.81 and 2.59 respectively, and being placed in the

B+, B and B+ grade in the 1st, 2nd and 3rd cycle respectively.

The college has a vision of imparting value based quality education to the learners. Being situated in a rural locality, about 80% of the students hail from rural areas with very weak financial and academic background as well as poor academic base. So, the college undertakes all possible measures to uplift academic as well as extra academic performance of such students.

The college also has the vision to be a regional leader in imparting value-based quality education and empower individuals to become self reliant, caring and responsible global citizens with a lifelong zest for learning and self employment.

Institutional Strength:

- Duliajan College is the oldest HEI in Duliajan with an experience of five and a half decade of imparting quality learning in the field of higher education.
- 18 departments are offering a number of UG, Add-on, Diploma, Certificate and Higher Secondary programmes.
- Two open and distance learning (ODL) study centers in the college is catering the need of higher education of the employed people as well as poor aspirants of the locality.
- The students excel beyond classrooms, participating in co-curricular and extracurricular activities by joining various societies and developing organizational skills and spirit of teamwork.
- Environmentally sustainable practices of waste management through in-house composting.
- Gender-sensitive education is at the heart of Duliajan College. The Internal Complaints Committee, Women Cell of Duliajan College, Women cell of Duliajan College Teachers' Unit, Equal Opportunity Cell, Well Being Oasis Club provide support to all students and create a safe and enabling space for women empowerment.
- The college fosters and encourages research and innovation among the students and faculties through several programs, including publication of Students' research journal, the college's interdisciplinary peer-reviewed research journals, and constituting a dedicated Research Development Cell (RDC).
- Academic collaboration with a number of institutions for student and faculty exchange programmes.
- Well-equipped Gymnasium, Indoor Stadium, Play Ground and Auditorium catering to the needs of both institutional as well as neighbourhood community.
- One botanical garden, one fruits garden and one virgin micro-forest are a catering the need of germplasm conservation of economically important as well as medicinal plants and herbs.
- Almost zero incidences of ragging, gender-based violence and other forms of student unrest or protests.
- Active NSS and NCC units involving the students in different in-house and outdoor community services.

• With strong emphasis on timely delivery of curriculum, Duliajan College ensures an effective student-centric teaching-learning environment. It focuses on dialogical learning, continuous assessment, mentoring and a regular feedback mechanism.

Institutional Weakness:

- Although the college has classrooms with ICT-enabled facilities, improvement with this facility is needed.
- Lack of large size well equip seminar hall
- Lack of PG courses
- Less focus on add-on as well as skill development courses.

Institutional Opportunity:

- To establish a formal linkage with Oil India Limited, a premiere oil and gas exploration company located at Duliajan as a part of the Industry Academia linkage in order to avail the financial and HR support to run various vocational courses relevant to the Oil industry and infrastructural facilities to support the academic activities of the students.
- There is immense scope to strengthen waste management initiatives and programs, recycling and compost units, and water recycling.
- To enhance the use of renewable solar energy in the College campus.
- Project-based learning in UG programs provides opportunities for Duliajan College to focus on research, innovation and entrepreneurship. Duliajan College will provide a sustained platform for research publication to faculty and students by launching peer-reviewed Scopus-indexed research journals.
- Duliajan College will strengthen its placement cell by enhancing career counseling programs and placement strategies for increased employability.
- Duliajan College will focus on skill enhancement and add-on certificate courses for capacity building.

Institutional Challenges:

- To meet the deficit of adequate academic staff in a number of departments for smooth running of various programs from limited internal resources of the college.
